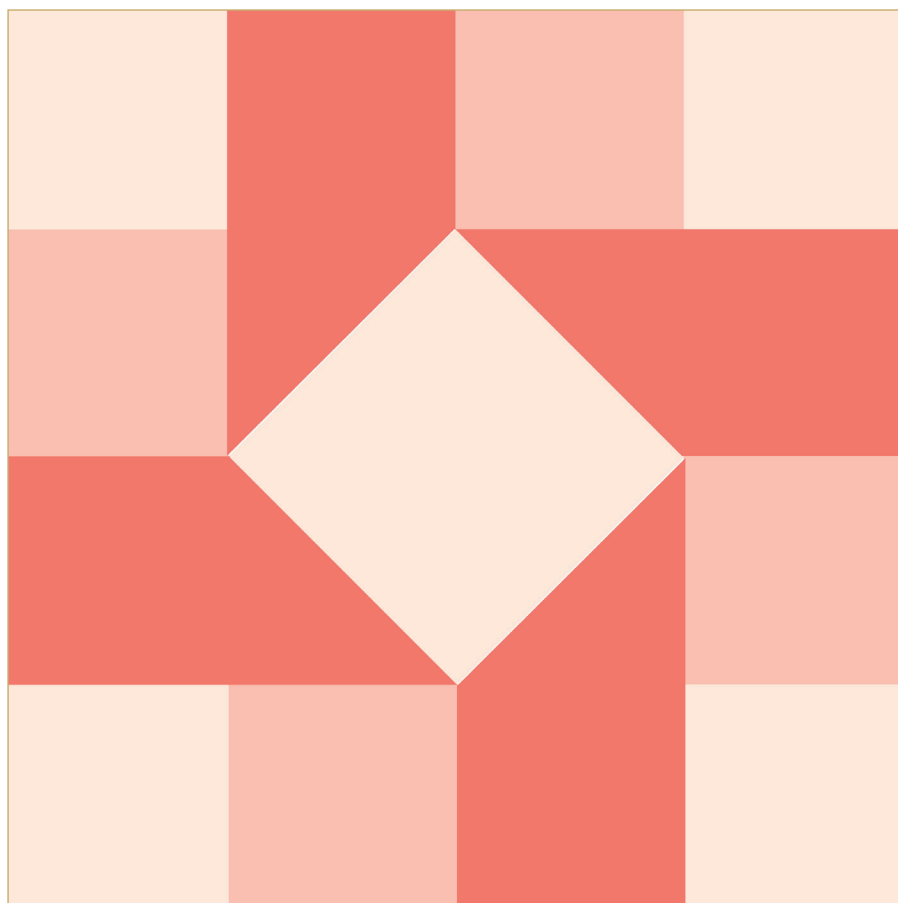


The Oh Susannah Quilt Block Pattern

(in 7 different sizes)



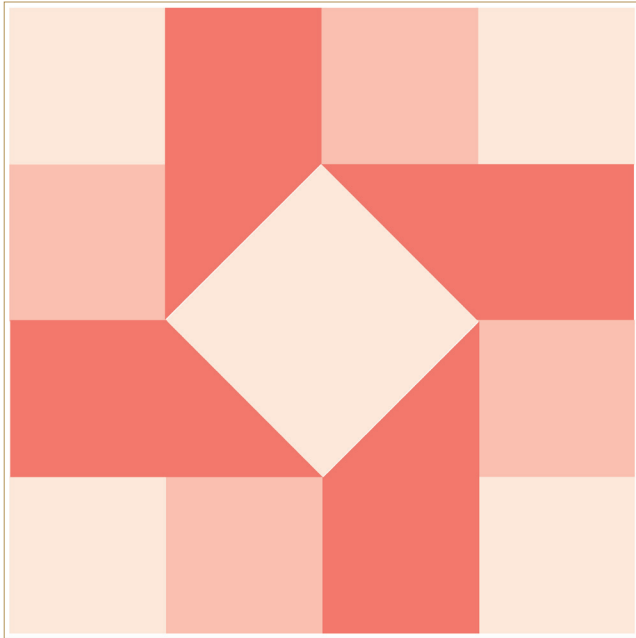

The Oh Susannah Quilt Block Pattern



You need 3 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 10" block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:



= Subcut once on the diagonal

= Subcut twice on the diagonal

Sew all pieces together using a 1/4" seam and a 2.0mm stitch. Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 10" finished block, your block should measure 10.5")

Block Assembly:

Arrange your patches as shown in the exploded diagram, paying careful attention to color placement

Make the Central SNS Unit using the Quick Corner Method using the large light square and 4 of the dark squares that you cut.

Sew a medium and a dark square together, and then sew a pair to each side of the SNS unit. This becomes your middle row.

Next sew the blocks together in the top and bottom rows.

Finally, sew all three rows together.
