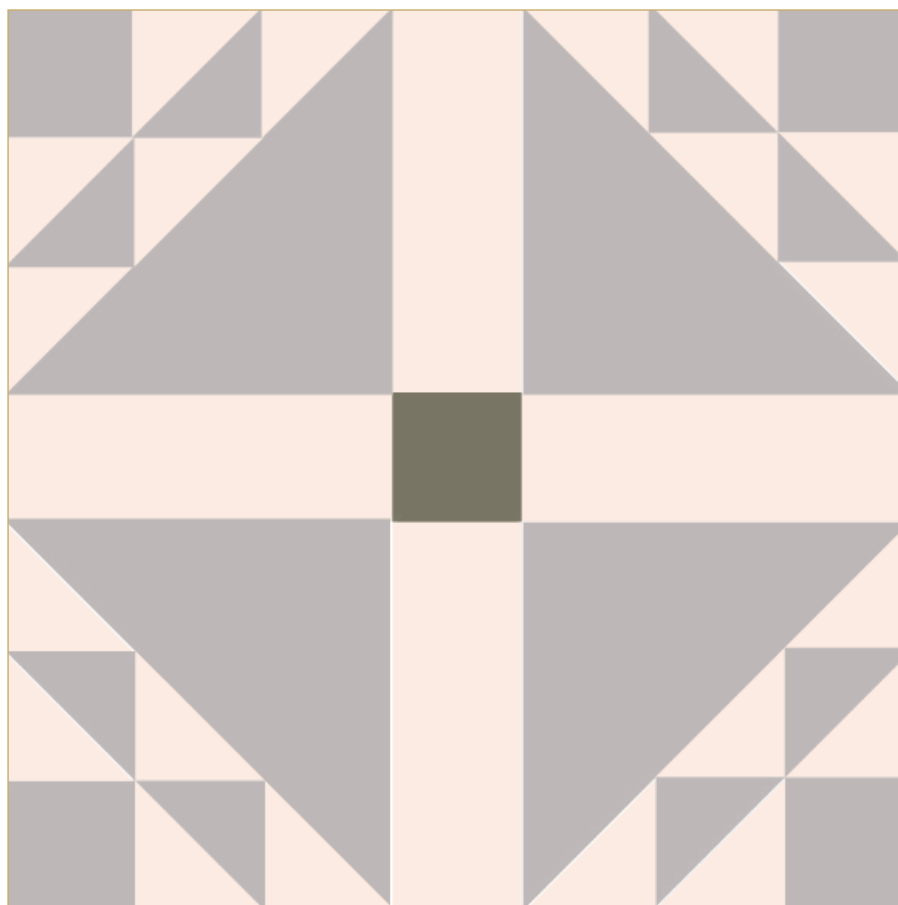


The Dove In A Window Quilt Block Pattern (in 3 different sizes)



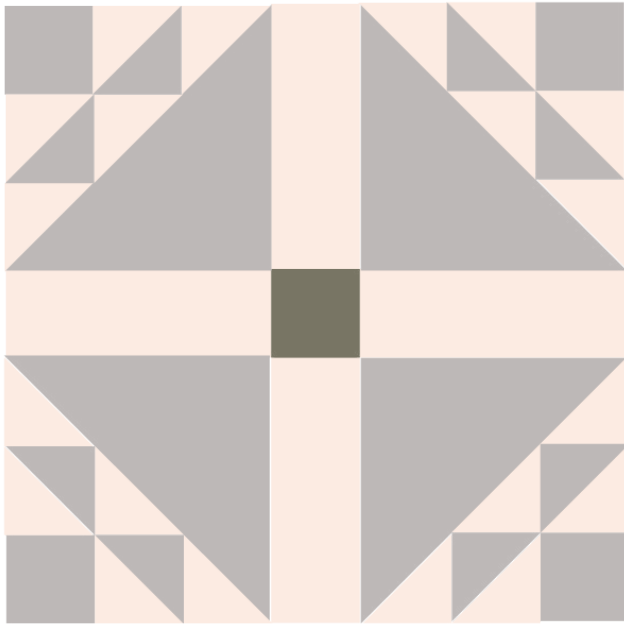

The Dove In A Window Quilt Block Pattern



You need 3 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 7" block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:



= Subcut once on the diagonal

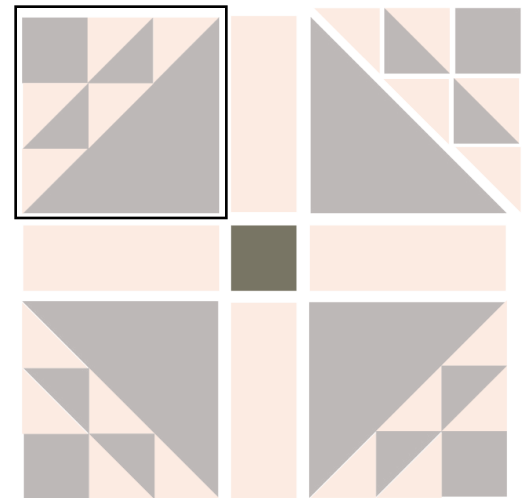
= Subcut twice on the diagonal

Sew all pieces together using a 1/4" seam and a 2.0mm stitch. Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 14" finished block, your block should measure 14.5")

Corner Unit



Block Assembly:

Arrange your pieces as shown in the exploded diagram. To make the four corner units, first make 8 small HST units. Attach these to the small outer square and the remaining HST pieces to make 1/2 of a large corner unit. Sew this 1/2 corner unit to the large half square triangle that you cut to form corner unit.

Assemble the remaining pieces like a 9-patch.
