## The Dove In A Window Quilt Block Pattern

(in 3 different sizes)


Skill level: Intermediate

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## You need 3 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 7 " block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:

= Subcut once on the diagonal
$=$ Subcut twice on the diagonal
Sew all pieces together using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam and a 2.0 mm stitch. Your unfinished block should measure $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ more than your finished size. (i.e. For a $14^{\prime \prime}$ finished block, your block should measure $14.5^{\prime \prime}$ )

## Block Assembly:

Arrange your pieces as shown in the exploded diagram. To make the four corner units, first make 8 small HST units. Attach these to the small outer square and the remaining HST pieces to make $1 / 2$ of a large corner unit. Sew this $1 / 2$ corner unit to the large half square triangle that you cut to form corner unit.
Assemble the remaining pieces like a 9 -patch.
