## The Double X Quilt Block Pattern



## You need 2 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 6" block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:

= Subcut once on the diagonal
= Subcut twice on the diagonal
Sew all pieces together using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam and a 2.0 mm stitch. Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 9" finished block, your block should measure 9.5")

## Block Assembly:

1.) Make all your HST using your light and dark triangles. (Make 12)
2.) Assemble your HST's and your remaining pieces as shown in the exploded diagram at the right.
3.) Sew all the units together in each row, then sew the rows together to complete the block.
