


The Double X Quilt Block Pattern

(in 5 different sizes)





The Double X Quilt Block Pattern



You need 2 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 6" block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:



= Subcut once on the diagonal



= Subcut twice on the diagonal

Sew all pieces together using a 1/4" seam and a 2.0mm stitch. Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 9" finished block, your block should measure 9.5")

Block Assembly:

- 1.) Make all your HST using your light and dark triangles. (Make 12)
- 2.) Assemble your HST's and your remaining pieces as shown in the exploded diagram at the right.
- 3.) Sew all the units together in each row, then sew the rows together to complete the block.
