## The Friendship Star Quilt Block Pattern



## You need 2 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 6" block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:

= Subcut once on the diagonal
= Subcut twice on the diagonal
Sew all pieces together using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam and a 2.0 mm stitch.
Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 10 " finished block, your block should measure 10.5")

## Cutting Chart:

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## Block Assembly:

Arrange your pieces as shown in the exploded diagram. First sew your HST pieces to make squares.
You can then sew all the pieces together as a 9-patch.
