


The David and Goliath Quilt Block Pattern

(in 3 different sizes)





The David and Goliath Quilt Block Cutting Chart



You need 5 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 5" block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:



= Subcut once on the diagonal




= Subcut twice on the diagonal

Sew all pieces together using a 1/4" seam and a 2.0mm stitch. Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 10" finished block, your block should measure 10.5")

Cutting Chart:

Note: if you prefer the Quick Sew method for making HSTs, do not subcut pieces..

Block Assembly:

Arrange your pieces as shown in the exploded diagram above and sew pieces together using a scant 1/4" seam.
