


The Lover's Tiff Quilt Block Pattern





The Lover's Tiff Quilt Block Pattern




You need 3 fabrics ranging from light to dark.





Use the chart below to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. For example, if you want a 7" block, you would use the measurements given in the highlighted column below. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut either once or twice on the diagonal.



Cutting Chart:

Block Assembly:

NOTE: For all seams, use a scant 1/4" seam and a 2.0 mm stitch length.

Arrange your patches as shown in the diagram above. First, sew together the HSTs, then make the 4-patch units.

Next, sew the patches in each row together. Finally connect all the rows to each other.

Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 7" finished block, your block should measure 7.5")
