

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The Twin Star Quilt Block Pattern



You need 4 fabrics ranging from light to dark.



Use the chart below to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. For example, if you want a 10" block, you would use the measurements given in the highlighted column below. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut either once or twice on the diagonal.

Block Assembly:


NOTE: For all seams, use a scant 1/4" seam and a 2.0 mm stitch length.

Arrange your patches as shown in the diagram at right. Pay careful attention to color and position placement of your Half Square Triangle pieces and your Quarter Square Triangle Pieces.

Assemble the four Y units by first sewing the two QST pieces together and then sewing them opposite the gold HST pieces.

Assemble the remainder of the block together in typical 9-patch fashion.

Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 10" finished block, your block should measure 10.5")
