

## Maple Star Quilt Block Pattern

(in 3 different sizes)


Skill level: Confident Beginner - Intermediate

## The Attic Window Quilt Block Pattern



You need 4 fabrics ranging from light to dark.


Use the chart to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. (For a 6" block, use the measurements in the highlighted column.) When only one measurement is given in the chart, that indicates that the piece is cut as a square of that size. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut:

= Subcut once on the diagonal
$=$ Subcut twice on the diagonal
Sew all pieces together using a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam and a 2.0 mm stitch. Your unfinished block should measure $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 10 " finished block, your block should measure 10.5")

## Block Assembly:

Arrange your pieces as shown in the exploded diagram at right. First sew your flying geese units using the sew 'n flip method. Then assemble each row. Once each row is complete, sew the 5 rows together to complete the block.
