THE MORE THE MERRIER

The more colors used, the more interesting the quilt. Together, they are a rainbow.



SHOP YOUR SELVAGE

Don't forget to use these helpful colors of color. They're the perfect choice to find a match.




STICK WITH A DESIGNER

They've already done the hard color theory work for you.



1 COLOR +

One color plus a neutral background is a MONOCHROMATIC color scheme. But sometimes these become ANALOGOUS.



PLAY WITH SWATCHES

USE A MOOD BOARD TO INSPIRE YOURSELF. SORT OUT THE COLORS ARE WORKING FOR YOU.



THE FABRIC PULL

Pulling from your stash to find a combination that just works.



PULL FROM A FOCUS FABRIC

Again, the designer has already done the heavy color choices in the fabric. Your mission is just to find fabric that fits.



THE 2-COLOR QUILT

Or two colors plus a neutral background. Often, these turn out to be designs based on the color wheel.




CHASE RAINBOWS
