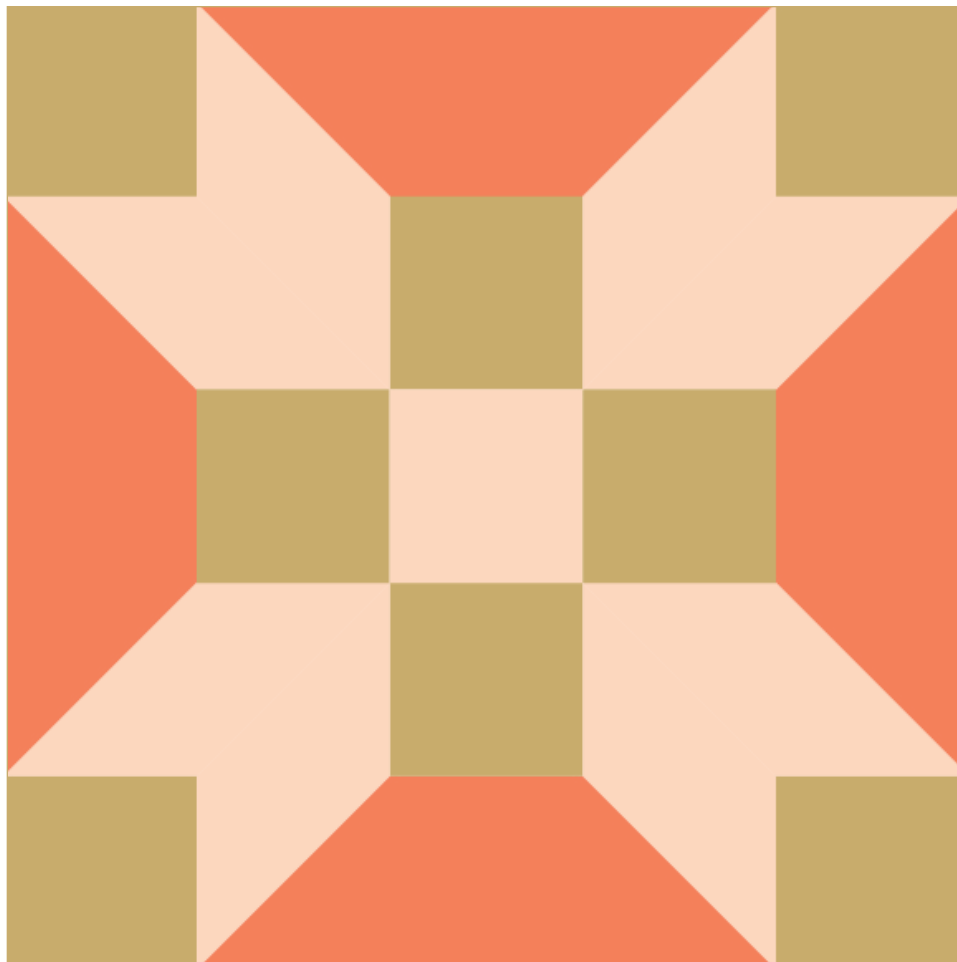

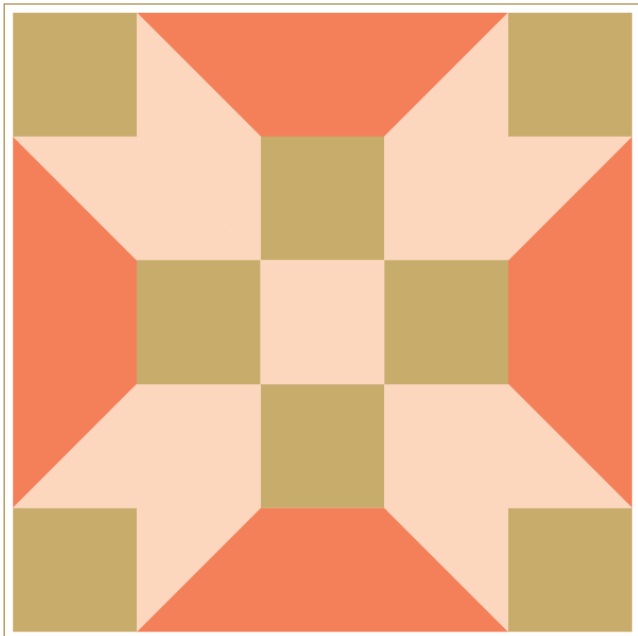


The Farmer's Daughter Quilt Block Pattern

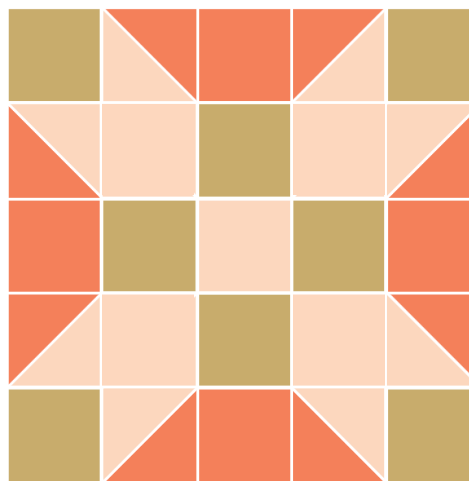


You will need 3 fabrics ranging in value from light to dark.



Cutting Chart:

		FINISHED SIZE	
Patch Shape	Subcut?	10"	
Cut 8	 No	2 1/2"	
Cut 4	 No	2 1/2"	
Cut 4	 	2 7/8"	
Cut 5	 No	2 1/2"	
Cut 4	 	2 7/8"	



Block Construction:

NOTE: For all seams, you should use a scant 1/4" seam and a 2.0 mm stitch length. Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than the finished size you are making. (i.e. For a 6" finished block, your block should measure 6.5")

Arrange your patches as shown in the exploded diagram.

First sew all HST (Half Square Triangle) units together to make squares, pressing to the dark side.

Next, sew all units together in each row.

Finally, sew all rows together. Your unfinished block should measure 10" square.
