

The Tea Leaf Quilt Block Pattern (in 7 different sizes)

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You need 3 fabrics ranging from light to dark.

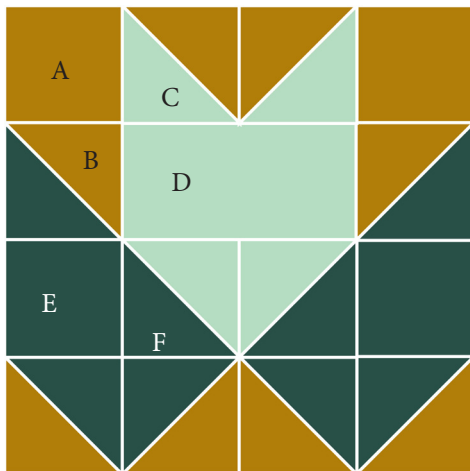


Use the chart below to determine what size to cut your patchwork pieces. For example, if you want a 6" block, you would use the measurements given in the highlighted column below. The chart may also indicate that some of your squares may need to be subcut either once or twice on the diagonal.

Block Assembly:

NOTE: For all seams, use a scant 1/4" seam and a 2.0 mm stitch length.

Arrange your patches as shown in the diagram at left. Pay careful attention to the placement of the Half Square Triangles, making sure they are turned the correct way.



First sew all HST (Half Square Triangle) units together to make squares. Press each HST to the dark side. Then sew together HST's with the squares and or rectangles needed to make each row. Finally, sew all rows together to finish the block

Your unfinished block should measure 1/2" more than your finished size. (i.e. For a 6" finished block, your block should measure 6.5")
